Revised Agenda

In accordance with Massachusetts General Law, c. 30A, §20B, the Board of Selectmen shall convene an emergency meeting to confirm the Town's intentions to take certain precautions in response to the evolving public health emergency.

Contemplated actions include:

- 1) A potential determination by the Town Moderator, in accordance with Massachusetts General Law, c. 39, s. 10A to ***postpone the March 28th Annual and Special Town Meetings*** to a time certain, recognizing the possibility of additional postponements should circumstances require;
- 2) A potential vote of the Board of Selectmen to file special legislation (i.e., a so-called Governor's Bill) requesting expedited approval to postpone the Annual Town Election;
- 3) A potential vote of the Board of Selectmen, in consultation with the Town Clerk, to postpone the Annual Town Election; and
- 4) Various other possible measures to suspend non-essential meetings and events.
