2) Placemaking

- a. Green area behind Donelan's
 - i. This space has designs going back to 1999, followed by The Conway School, Ken's designs, and Lemon Brooke. We have applied for a grant 3 times and unfortunately hasn't been funded.
 - ii. What is this green space and what should it be called besides "the green space behind Donelan's"
 - iii. Where do we go now? What plans does the RLF have for this space?
 - iv. Lincoln Woods desires a playground and has some ideas about different places to site it.
 - v. Are their opportunities for collaboration between the Town, RLF and Lincoln Woods?
 - vi. What funding sources are out there? Crowdfunding, Grants, CPA etc.
