

LCC minutes Jan 2020 DRAFT

The Lincoln Cemetery Commission held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, January 14, 2020 at 10 a.m. in Town Offices. Present were: Manley Boyce, Chair; Susan Harding and Rob Todd, Commissioners; and, Valerie Fox, Agent.

- 1) The minutes of the December board meeting were accepted as written.
- 2) There were two interments to record: Virginia Allison on November 11, 2019 as cremains; and, Ian Fitzgerald on December 23, 2019, in a full burial.
- 3) The deed for Lot #955A (Kafina) was signed by the Commission in December.
- 4) Other Business
  - a. The Commission authorized a \$5,000 appropriation request for the 2020 Annual Town Meeting to cover maintenance and tree work.
  - b. Manley asked for suggestions of what to include in the Annual Town Report from the Cemetery Commission.
  - c. The Commission approved the article for the Lincoln Squirrel drafted by Susan, with a few changes and corrections (see attached). She will also send Alice Waugh a copy of the meeting with Mt. Auburn as background and mention that the Town of Stow has regulations for natural burial.
  - d. The Commission is waiting to hear from Jane Layton about adding plaques to the Lexington Road Cemetery's signs prohibiting recreational parking and commercial dog walking. This new regulation will be mentioned in the Town Report so everyone is made aware of it officially.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:50 a.m.
