

BPAC minutes

Friday, 10/23/20, first site at 12 noon

Visited the following sites:

- Trapelo Road causeway- discussed pedestrian and bike access across the causeway, the intersection of Old County and Trapelo Roads, and connecting the Trapelo roadside path to the causeway.
- Winter Street at Old County Road- discussed options for a full contraflow bike/ped lane and other measures on Winter Street between Old County Road and Waltham.
- Five Corners (intersections of Trapelo, Sandy Pond, Bedford, Lincoln, and Weston Roads)- discussed hazards for bikes and peds and possible interventions to correct.
- Bedford Road and Route 2- discussed completing/improving pedestrian crossing of Rt 2, the “jug handle”, and Bedford Road. Also consideration of safety upgrades for road cyclists.
- Bedford Lane path in MMNP from Bedford Lane to Rt 2A- discussed upgrading path so would be rideable for family cyclists and on road bikes (similar to Bedford Lane path north of Rt 2A); a crosswalk across 2A to connect two sections of Bedford Lane safely.

No decisions were made at any location. David Loutzenheiser to consider options and report back to BPAC.
