

LCC Minutes November 10, 2020 DRAFT

The Lincoln Cemetery Commission held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, November 10, 2020 at 10 a.m. in Town Offices. Present were Manley Boyce, chair; Rob Todd, commissioner; Valerie Fox, Cemetery agent.

1. A moment was taken to remember Commissioner Susan Harding who passed away this month.
2. There was one internment: Mark Hagenian in full burial.
3. There were no deeds to be signed.
4. Other business:
 - a. The Commission approved the placement of cremains in the Gruneberg lot and will continue to consider a small, slanted upright monument being placed.
 - b. The Commission discussed the Boit request for the purchase of an additional plot; they will continue to review the request. Valerie will discuss with the family the number of burials they need and whether they are planning on full or cremation burials.
 - c. The Commission is reviewing a request from Goldblatt to purchase an addition plot. Valerie will review their original lot.
 - d. The Commission discussed the Isaacs request for four plots; the purchase of two was approved, but the other two were denied. This is concurrent with the Cemetery Commission's rule about number of lots a single family can purchase.
 - e. The Commission is reviewing a request to plant a dogwood tree in the French lot. Manley will review the lot and determine if the tree would be placed against the rear of the cemetery.
 - f. The Commission is reviewing a request by the Hatsopoulos family to buy an additional plot. Manley will review the original plot purchase.
 - g. The Commission discussed Joey Cotoni's hours for the remainder of the season. It was decided that he will stay on to finish work with the flags.
 - h. The Commission discussed an inquiry by Amanda Hill about hiring a private company to place a monument in her lot, this was approved.
 - i. The Commission discussed the placement of a bench in the Cybulak lot. The dimensions were within those allowed so this was approved.
 - j. The Commission discussed the sale of a lot to Sartori, this was approved.
 - k. The Commission approved the sale of a lot to the Ory family with the reminder that the number of possible burials cannot be guaranteed.
 - l. The Carmody request to buy a lot is under review by the Commission.
 - m. The Commission approved the Napier request to place a flower display over the monument in her plot.
 - n. The Veteran's flags were discussed by the Commission. It was decided that any flags in poor shape will be replaced before winter. Steve McDonald will be asked to review the existing flags and replace them.

The meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m. The date of the next meeting is Tuesday, December 8, 2020 at 10 a.m.
