Town of Lincoln Dog Licensing Requirements

- A dog six months old or older must be licensed yearly.
- Dogs six months of age or older that are new to Lincoln must be licensed within 30 days of arrival.
- The license is valid for one calendar year, January 1 to December 31, and must be renewed annually by or before March 31.
- Certificate of current rabies vaccination is required, unless currently on file.
- Certificate of spaying or neutering is required, unless currently on file.
- Licensing fees as follows: \$10 for each neutered animal; \$15 for unneutered animals; late fee of \$5 after March 31.
- Please be aware that failure to license may result in referral to the Town's Animal Control Officer.
- Application to license your dog(s) may be made by mail or in person at the Town Clerk's Office.
