

Recommendations for a Lincoln Historical Commission FY2005 Request to the Community Preservation Committee

Project: Historical Survey

Town Committee: Lincoln Historical Commission

Brief Description:

The Historical Commission is seeking to identify and survey historic properties in Lincoln, with surveys filed with the Massachusetts Historical Commission as well as in Lincoln. Based upon a preliminary study (funded by the town for \$1,000), the current survey project (\$13,500 of CPC request, plus a \$10,000 grant approved by the Codman Trust) will complete the survey of Lincoln's houses and public buildings dating before 1900. The CPC request also includes funding a preliminary study (\$1,500 of CPC request) to identify barns, post-1900 houses, and other structures for subsequent survey work.

How does this project help preserve Lincoln's character or further its mission?

This town-wide survey work provides the basis for much of the town's and state's preservation work. It serves as the basis for establishing Local Historic Districts, and the Commission intends to use the surveys work to seek to expand the town's Local Historic Districts, providing a significant increase in the protection of the town's historic properties. The survey work will also supply the Commission with both the information and potential justification it needs in determining whether to invoke the Demolition Delay provisions of the town's by-laws when historic properties are threatened with demolition, as well as determining properties that it would consider eligible for future CPC historic preservation grants. The work is also coordinated with the Lincoln Assessors, who used the updated information on the dates of properties in their assessment process. At the state level, the surveys are also the resource used to determine properties eligible for the National Register, and for selecting properties for the State Register. Delay in the project would delay or hinder the town's opportunities for implementing these and other preservation options.

In reviewing the study areas of pre-1900 structures that have been earmarked by the Lincoln Historical Commission (plus those post-1900 structures that the Commission added to the list), along with the priority rankings given to properties by the Commission, I would suggest that the following study areas be the subject of the initial survey work under the Codman grant:

South Lincoln Village (study area K)
South Great Road (area M)
Concord Road (area O)
Pierce Hill (area I)
Lincoln Center (area A).

Collectively, these study areas contain a significant percentage of those properties that have not been surveyed and were identified by the Commission with a "1" or "1*" (the highest level of significance), including all but two (Storrow and Emily Osgood) of the 1* properties.

The attached list identifies under the "Cost" column the specific properties that I would recommend for this phase of the survey work.
