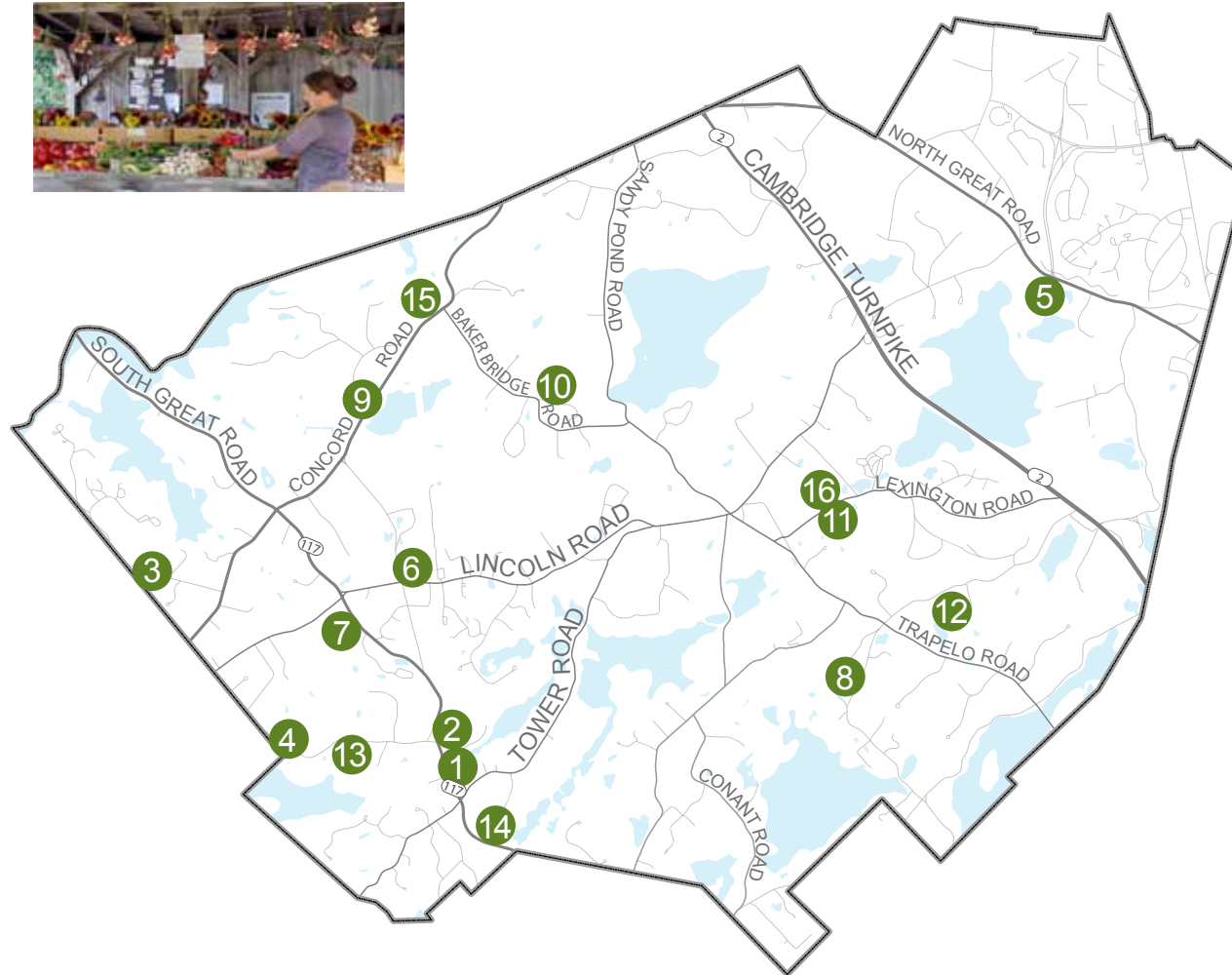

Lincoln has been a farming community since the 1650s. In 2013 Lincoln has almost 500 acres in active agriculture.

The March 2011 Town Meeting voted to pass the Right to Farm bylaw which affirms our farmers' right to manage their farms using best management practices, as provided under state law.

The Lincoln Agriculture Commission was created by Town Meeting vote in 2006 to: "preserve, protect and promote agriculture in Lincoln...The Commission will also seek further protections for existing lands, the identification of new lands for agricultural use, both public and private, and work to assist in natural resource management that is consistent with sustainable Agricultural practices."
