

## Lincoln Cemetery Commission Minutes – April 12, 2022

The Lincoln Cemetery Commission held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, April 12, 2022, at 10:38 a.m. at Town Offices. Present: Rob Todd, Chair, Manley Boyce, Commissioner, Doug Harding, Commissioner, and Valerie Fox, Cemetery agent. Cara Maroney, Assistant Town Clerk, was present also.

1. The Cemetery Commissioners accepted the minutes from the LCC March meeting.
2. The Commissioners agreed that the statue cover for the boy and dog statue would be removed for the season.
3. The Commission reviewed the upright monuments and markers that are scheduled to be placed at the cemetery. The Commissioners approved the markers and monuments for Jackson, Ruland, Issacs, and Solomon.
4. Manley confirmed the caretaker position is no longer filled and the DPW will help with clean up and maintenance.
5. The cost of a disinterment was discussed. The disinterment fee for a full burial is \$1,500. The Commissioners agreed that the disinterment fee for cremains is \$300 on a weekday and \$500 on a weekend.
6. The new sign is up in the Lincoln Cemetery that informs residents about the rules for parking and dog walking.
7. The Cemetery Commission approved Harry Klane to take photographs of the cemetery for a project.
8. The Cemetery Commissioners expressed their plan to walk through the Lincoln Cemetery together to discuss details of future projects.
9. Manley expressed that Fernway section is open. Manley confirmed the DPW said the new section is all set for plot sales. Manley stated will we be receiving a new map to show the Fernway section.
10. The Commissioners discussed that we would need an updated map to include the Fernway section.

The meeting adjourned at 11:31 a.m.
