DISCUSSION & Updates

Master Plan – Reviewed draft and changes made in preparation for upcoming presentations to several town boards & committees.

- Chris Murphy shared a heat map tool he created that helps zero in on current bike activity throughout town - something we may incorporate into the plan
- Next steps on plan:
 - Page 16 - reconcile “key initiatives” section with townwide project list
 - Page 23 - initiate long term plans for a rail to trail segment through Lincoln to connect with regional network
 - Road conditions section - engage with DPW on budget needed to make needed fixes throughout town; discussed possibility of incorporating tools such as SeeClickFix app employed by neighboring towns
 - Create PDF to start distributing draft throughout town with notes about sections still under construction
