

Lincoln Cemetery Commission Minutes – June 14, 2022

The Lincoln Cemetery Commission held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, May 24, 2022, at 10a.m. at Town Offices. Present: Manley Boyce, Chair, Rob Todd, Commissioner, Doug Harding, Commissioner, and Valerie Fox, Cemetery Agent. Cara Maroney, Assistant Town Clerk, was present also.

1. The Cemetery Commission signed the deeds for the new lots purchased in the Lincoln Cemetery.
2. The Commission was informed of the upcoming interments to take place in the Lincoln Cemetery.
3. The Commissioners approved the monument for the Pace family.
4. The Commissioners approved the plot purchase for the Brayton family.
5. The Commissioners clarified that the landscapers are scheduled to take care of the Arbor Vitae Cemetery weekly.
6. Valerie notified the Cemetery Commission that a snapping turtle has made a nest in the Lincoln Cemetery. The Conservation Department marked the area with stakes and signs to keep the turtle and eggs protected. The Commissioners agreed this was the best practice to keep the area secure.
7. The Commissioners approved the cemetery plot request for the Curtiss family.
8. The Cemetery Commission discussed that the DPW removed the damaged Veteran's marker and a new Veteran's marker was placed in the Lincoln Cemetery for John Tavolieri.
9. The Cemetery Commission stated the Lincoln Cemetery map will need to be updated to include the Fernway Section. Rob stated he will sketch a rough draft to include the new section.
10. The Commissioners expressed that the Town will be notified of seasonal clean up. The Cemetery Commission agreed to place a sign in the Lincoln Cemetery to notify the residents of the dates and remind the lot owners to remove any personal items.

The meeting adjourned at 11:07 am.
