

## Lincoln Cemetery Commission Minutes – July 12, 2022

The Lincoln Cemetery Commission held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, July 12, 2022, 10 a.m. at Town Offices. Present: Manley Boyce, Chair, Rob Todd, Commissioner, Doug Harding, Commissioner, and Valerie Fox, Cemetery Agent. Cara Maroney, Assistant Town Clerk, was present also.

1. The Cemetery Commission signed the deeds for the new lots purchased in the Lincoln Cemetery.
2. Valerie informed the Cemetery Commission of the recent interments for Nancy Rawson, Claire Pearmain, John Manzelli Jr., and Irene Hagenian.
3. The Commissioners approved the flat marker for the Leo family.
4. The Commissioners approved the monument for the Rappaport family.
5. The Commissioners clarified the type of marker permitted for the Kolligian family.
6. The Commission approved the lot purchase for the Spindler family.
7. The Commissioners discussed the Fernway section and their plan to establish the lots that are unavailable. They will obtain a copy of the map from the Conservation Department to mark the unavailable lots on the map.
8. Valerie informed the Commission that Harry Klane will begin his photography project. Harry Klane will be taking photographs of the cemeteries in Lincoln and focusing on stones that were installed prior to the 1800s.
9. The Cemetery Commission voiced the idea to have the DPW use a spray paint to mark the plots instead of stakes.
10. The Commissioners expressed the need for the DPW to clean up a large branch that fell in the Arbor Vitae Cemetery.
