

Lincoln Cemetery Commission Minutes – August 9, 2022

The Lincoln Cemetery Commission held its monthly meeting on Tuesday, August 9, 2022 at 10 A.M. at Town Offices. Present: Manley Boyce, Chair, Rob Todd, Commissioner, Doug Harding, Commissioner, and Valerie Fox, Cemetery Agent. Cara Maroney, Assistant Town Clerk, was present also.

1. The Cemetery Commission approved the minutes for July 12, 2022.
2. The Cemetery Commission signed the deed for the lot JF-285 purchased by Dorothy Curtiss.
3. The Commissioners agreed to notify the DPW of a fallen tree that damaged the Hurff monument. The Commissioners agreed to follow up with Acton Monument if needed to fix the damaged stone.
4. Valerie informed the Cemetery Commission of the recent interments for Anthony Buendia and Kathleen Huber.
5. Manley informed the Commission of residents interested in purchasing a cemetery plot.
6. The Commissioners determined they will review the Gillis lot to determine what is permitted for the monument and landscape.
7. The Commission approved the lot purchase for the Capizzi family.
8. Valerie addressed the concerns about the Styron Monument and informed the family about the status of their monument.
9. The Commissioners approved the flat marker for the Ide Family.
10. The Commissioners approved the monument for the Davis family.
11. The Commissioners were informed that Jim Cunningham is the owner for lot 862 and has provided a notarized letter to permit Susan Frommer and her husband to be buried in lot 862.
12. The Cemetery Commission approved the monument for Robert Lemire.
13. The Commissioners approved the flat marker for Anthony Buendia.
14. The Commissioners addressed the Horwitz family request for landscaping and determined that landscaping is not permitted in a flat marker area.
15. The Commissioners addressed the gate at the entrance to Lincoln Cemetery and the need for it to be repaired.
