

Lincoln Cemetery Commission Minutes – October 11, 2022

The Lincoln Cemetery Commission held its monthly meeting on Tuesday, October 11, 2022, at Town Offices. Present: Manley Boyce, Chair, Rob Todd, Commissioner, Doug Harding, Commissioner, and Valerie Fox, Cemetery Agent. Cara Maroney, Assistant Town Clerk, was present also.

The meeting opened at 10am.

1. The Cemetery Commission approved the minutes for September 13, 2022.
2. The Cemetery Commissioners signed the deed for the McCarthy lot purchase.
3. The Commissioners reviewed the interments for James Cunningham, Margaret Stathos, Robert Curtiss, Thomas Williamson, and Marion Allison.
4. The Commissioners approved the monument for the Milender family and the Congdon family.
5. The Cemetery Commission reviewed the Cunningham estate and established the Frommer family is permitted to be buried in the Cunningham lot.
6. The Commissioners discussed a draft of a letter that outlines the rules and regulations for natural burials.
7. The Cemetery Commission acknowledged Steve DeFina for his maintenance of the Lincoln Cemetery.
8. The Commission approved the monument for the Tingley family.
9. The request was approved by the Cemetery Commission to permit the Merriam family to be buried in the Flint lot.
10. The Cemetery Commission meeting for November was rescheduled to Tuesday, November 15, 2022.
11. The Commissioners discussed the plans to define the area of the cemetery that will be used for natural burials.
12. The Cemetery Commission reviewed the office maps of the Lincoln Cemetery and determined which maps to keep in the office.
