Public Forum to review Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan with a focus on East Lincoln

- Master Plan review with focus on East Lincoln (North of Rt 117, south of Rt 2 and east of Lincoln Rd / Bedford Rd)

Bob and Ginger discussed the draft Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan with attendees and solicited feedback. There was discussion around

- How to accommodate different types of bikers: children, mountain bikes, road bikes
- Trapelo & Old County Rd intersection dangers
- Minimizing signage and rural character
- Extending the Trapelo roadside path all the way to the reservoir
- Extending the 117 roadside path to the Weston line
- Cost of crosswalks
- The need for more roadside paths (sidewalks) in general
- Weston Rd, the potential of a one-way pilot
- Silver Hill rd speed of cars
- The need for a circulation study at the school campus as well as village center - routes onto campus not clear
- Speed humps, pros and cons
