Public Forum to review Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan with a focus on East Lincoln

- Master Plan review with focus on West Lincoln (North of Rt 117, south of Rt 2 and west of Lincoln Rd / Bedford Rd)

Bob and Ginger discussed the draft Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan with attendees and solicited feedback. There was discussion around

- Crosswalks, how safety is evaluated, if all that are in the plan are truly necessary
- Slip lane at Trapelo between the flower pot and the library
- What defines a multiuse path
- Village Center ideas
- DPW input, how do they feel about speed humps and roundabouts, given that the Lincoln Rd one was removed years ago
- State legislators don't always know how important Chapter 90 funds are to towns, that should be communicated to Tom Stanley and successors
- Use of the existing trail system
- Language in the master plan clarifying that acceptance of the plan does not imply immediate implementation of any project in the plan.
- Town Meeting process for the master plan
