GIRLS GRADES 5/6

Lincoln sends a team to participate in the Sudbury Intown League. Will practice in Lincoln, but follow the Sudbury League schedule, policies, and rules.

PRACTICE & GAME SCHEDULES

If any conflicts, please communicate with your respective coach prior to the season starting.

- Practices will be held during the week and will be scheduled based on coach availability and gym space!
- Games will take place on Saturdays between 9am and 2pm
- Games start December 6. Season has 8 games and 1 “playoff” game (see Playoff section)
- No games: December 27, January 3, February 14, and February 21
- Games for Girls Grades 5/6 will take place on Wednesday nights.

INCLEMENT WEATHER/GAME CANCELLATIONS

When inclement weather threatens the safety of travel in the league’s region, the league will consider canceling all games for that day. A decision will be made by the commissioner and coordinators. Any such league-wide cancellations will be posted on the league’s website as early as possible on game day and will be communicated by email from your respective coordinator. Also, in the case of league-wide cancellations, the TTYBL commissioner will contact the coordinator of league referees to alert them to the game cancellations.

Games canceled due to inclement weather **will not be rescheduled**. The league, in its discretion, may decide to schedule make-up games in the event that there are an unusually large number of games canceled due to inclement weather.

SPORTSMANSHIP

All members of the team and their fans should practice good sportsmanship before, during and after the game. Individuals should:

- Support the referees and refrain from making derogatory comments towards or about them
- Refrain from actions or words that undercut the self-esteem of players on other teams or their own team
- Do not make derogatory comments towards other players, coaches or referees
- Participate in post-game “nice game” exchange
- Avoid unnecessary rough and ‘dirty’ play.
- Good sportsmanship includes not running up the score. Please see the league rules for expectations around point differentials.

QUICKSCORES

The league will be using Quickscores software for game scheduling and team rankings. A link will be shared once that is all set for the season.

EQUAL PLAYING TIME

All players get equal playing time regardless of age, grade, or ability.
