Workdays focus on a range of stewardship tasks such as invasive plant management, data collection, native plant restoration, and trail maintenance.

Invasives: Continued removal of invasive vegetation from the forest understory

APRIL: SANDY POND TRUST Friday 04.10.2026, 1:00PM – 3:00PM

Invasives: Continued removal of invasive vegetation from field edge and forest understory

Trails: Trail treadway stabilization and water bar installation

MAY: BEAVER POND Saturday 05.09.2026, 9:00PM – 12:00PM

Invasives: Continued removal of invasive vegetation from the forest understory

Trails: Stabilize nearby bog bridge, stabilize trail treadway

JUNE: CODMAN SOUTH Friday 06.05.2026, 1:00PM – 3:00PM

Invasives: Continued removal of invasive vegetation from the forest understory

Monitoring: Record the species and abundance of native and invasive plants within the monitoring plot

Trails: Stabilize and install bog bridges

JULY: SUDBURY RIVER Friday 07.17.2026, 1:00PM – 4:00PM

DEADLINE TO SIGN UP FOR THIS EVENT IS JULY 10TH, 2026

Invasives: Help keep Lincoln's stretch of the Sudbury River free of invasive water chestnut.

AUGUST: MOUNT MISERY Saturday 08.15.2026, 9:00AM – 12:00PM

Invasives: Continued removal of invasive vegetation from the forest understory and pond shorelines

Monitoring / Restoration: Assess the restoration area and restore native plant protection

Trails: Stabilize trail treadway and install water bars
