Subject: Route 2 Lincoln - motorized toy car

Mark,

As a follow-up to our earlier conversation regarding the email from Vincent Valentine (dated 06/01/13), the following is a summary of the incident involving the child (2yrs/10months) who was operating the battery powered toy car.

On Sunday May 19th at 3:30pm, a motorist was traveling Route 2 west when his/her attention was drawn to a child operating a motorized toy car on Brooks Road and traveling in the direction of Route 2. Noticing that the child was alone and approaching Route 2, the motorist turned onto Brooks Road and stopped the child. The motorist called 911 which connected to the Massachusetts State Police. Troopers from the Concord Barracks and a Lincoln police officer responded to the area. While on the phone with the State Police, the child's adult caretaker arrived and took custody of the child.

It should be noted that the child is a resident of Smith Hill Road which is a neighborhood off of Brooks Road. At no time did the child cross over Route 2 or travel onto Route 2. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
