



Additions to Historic District & Brown's Wood Historic District, Town Meeting, May 15, 2021

- Decision to join Historic District is entirely voluntary by homeowner
- Assists Town with preservation of important buildings visible from public way, including footpaths
- Requires two-thirds majority vote at Town Meeting

- 1941 King House, John Freeman Bradley, architect
- Site of Baker Farm that Thoreau describes in *Walden*
- Olmsted designed meadow for Burnham-Adams estate
- All three original homes of Quincy Adams' innovative plan for estate will now be part of Historic District



**11 Moccasin Hill Road
Request to Join
Brown's Wood Historic District**

- 1975 Shamsky House, Reese & Bond, architects
- Features two-story, floor-to-ceiling windows salvaged from John Hancock Building in Boston
- 14 houses will now be part of Brown's Wood Historic District
