



For upgrading to Water Sense labeled irrigation controllers and sensors

The largest residential water use by far is for yard irrigation. Lincoln's daily water use nearly doubles in the summer! Use of drip irrigation for shrubs and flower beds and minimal lawn watering can make a huge difference. For automatic watering systems, use of moisture sensors not only saves substantial amounts of water but also promotes deep roots and discourages growth of ticks, mosquitos, and fungal diseases.
