UPDATED Information Regarding Weekend Service Suspension
EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY thru NOVEMBER 17th 2013

A review of upcoming construction schedules has allowed the opportunity for the MBTA to make efficiencies in the work schedule, allowing for weekend service on the Fitchburg Line to be maintained between North Station and South Acton Station though Labor Day Weekend.

The current weekend service outages from South Acton to Fitchburg will continue until the weekend of August 24th with full Saturday/Sunday service over the Labor Day weekend. Commencing the weekend of September 7th service will terminate at "Brandeis/Roberts Station.

Phase One: - Fitchburg to /from South Acton

The service reduction which began on June 1st, 2013 and will now continue through August 24th, 2013 the MBTA will continue to suspend weekend train service between Fitchburg and South Acton. The following stations will be closed: Fitchburg, North Leominster, Shirley, Ayer, and Littleton/Route 495.

Fitchburg Line trains (Inbound/Outbound) between South Acton and North Station will operate on the normal weekend schedule.

Customers are advised that there will be **NO REPLACEMENT BUS SERVICE.**

- **Train service will be provided on the following weekend ONLY during this time period:**
Labor Day Weekend - Saturday, August 31, Sunday, September 1st and Monday, (will operate on the Sunday schedule) September 2, 2013

Phase Two: - Fitchburg to/from Brandeis/Roberts

Starting September 7th, 2013 the service suspension will be extended to Brandeis/Roberts; the following additional stations will be closed: South Acton, West Concord, Concord, Lincoln, and Kendal Green.

Fitchburg Line trains (Inbound/Outbound) between Brandeis/Roberts and North Station will operate on the normal weekend schedule.

Customers are advised that there will be **NO REPLACEMENT BUS SERVICE.**

MBCR Customer Service will continue to send service updates as these projects continue. Customers can also visit the MBTA website at www.mbta.com - then click on "service updates".

Please note that weekday service will not be affected.

We do apologize for the inconvenience to our passengers during this necessary track work. Customers can look forward to significant service improvements once this project is completed.
