

Reverse 911 Announcement

RE: MBTA Construction Project

This is Police Chief Kevin Mooney calling to make all residents aware of significant MBTA construction that has begun on the railroad tracks and crossings throughout town. Weekend commuter rail service will be suspended beginning this weekend, September 7<sup>th</sup> through November 17<sup>th</sup>. We do expect to experience increased noise and other construction impacts, particularly during evening hours and on weekends when most of the construction activity will be taking place. Horns will sound as trains approach work zones. Roadway traffic will be rerouted while each of our crossings is under construction, beginning with the Tower Road crossing this weekend followed by Old Sudbury Road, South Great Road and Lincoln Road on successive weekends.
