I wonder if we should consider a process for opening up membership on an established town committee once enough interest and dissent has been registered regarding that committee's work? In that manner, the committee members (new and old) would hash it out publicly, transparently, and with a shared objective/town charge, to resolve differences to the extent possible and to present together where and why there are remaining points of disagreement. That way, the organized dissenting voices have the same playing field as the already established committee members, and part of what the entire committee would need to do is resolve differences as much as possible before town meeting. Alternatively, perhaps the Selects could appoint a second committee with the same charge, access to info and Open Meeting Law requirements for situations where there is substantial interest in having an alternative perspective engage with the charge, the policy, and the facts, so that both committees have similar objectives and constraints, if different policy objectives and views.
