April 19, 2025, Resident Credentialing

Credentialing- Residents living within the road closures will receive a color-coded hang tag for your vehicle's rearview mirror which will give you access to and from your residence at the 4 checkpoint locations. Residents can receive their hang tags at the Annual Town Meeting, Transfer Station (April 5th & April 12th), and can be picked up at the Public Safety Building after April 1st. Residents may also be given credentials on April 19th as they leave their home via one of the checkpoint locations by a Town of Lincoln staff member.

Police Staffed Checkpoints: The checkpoints will be located at Lexington Road North at Mill Street, Bedford Road at Juniper Ridge Road, Route 2A at the Concord town line (Exit 125), Virginia Road at Old Bedford Road (Concord). Residents must access their homes via their designated checkpoint as no vehicular traffic will be allowed along Route 2A in the Minuteman National Park.

Resident access points: If you live on one of these streets this is how you will access your home.

Access via Bedford Road via Route 2- Bedford Road (north of Rte. 2), Bedford Lane, Brooks Hill Road, Morningside Lane, Sunnyside Lane, Acorn Lane, Silver Birch, Juniper Ridge, Tracey's Corner.

Access via Lexington Road North at Route 2 West- Mill Street, Mill Street Ext., Oakdale Lane, Lexington Road (North), Reiling Pond Road

Access via Bypass Road via Exit 125- Bypass Road, Brooks Road, Smith Hill Road, Emerson Road, Horses Crossing

Access Bypass Road via Exit 125 to Lexington Road (Concord) to Old Bedford Road to Virginia Road (Concord) or via Route 62 (Concord)- Minuteman Commons, Battle Farm Road
