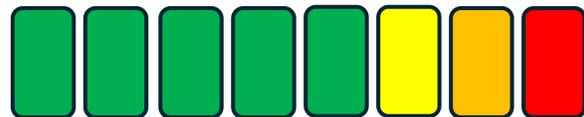

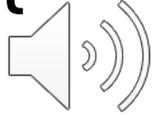
- Clicker By-law

Citizen Comment Period

- Line up behind the microphones
- Wait to be recognized by the Moderator
- Refrain from repeating a point already made
- Limit your comments to 2 minutes or less
- The timer will warn you as the time limit approaches
 - Yellow Bar = 30 seconds remaining
 - Orange Bar = 15 seconds remaining
 - Red Bar = time up



What should happen when a speaker exceeds their time allotment?

1. Moderator politely reminds speaker time is done
2. Final Jeopardy music
